Kendall Lake Shelter Area Closed For Construction Through 2009 *Winter Sports Center Hours Changed*

Brecksville, Ohio – A contractor working for the National Park Service is correcting hydrologic deficiencies of the Kendall Lake dam and removing accumulated sediment from the lake bottom. Construction work continues in the Kendall Lake shelter area, which includes the shelter, parking lots, and entrance and haul roads. This area will close to the public from midnight, Sunday, November 29, 2009 until the end of the year.

Previously scheduled hours for the Winter Sports Center at Kendall Lake Shelter have changed. The Winter Sports Center will be open on the following dates when there are at least four inches of snow: Saturdays and Sundays, January 2 through February 28; and the holidays of January 18 and February 15, 10 a.m. - 4 p.m. Trails in the area remain open, excepting a section of the Lake Trail crossing the dam.

Kendall Lake area is located at 1000 Kendall Park Road, 2 miles west of Akron Peninsula Road, Peninsula, Ohio 44264.
