NPS Seeking Information About Historic Structure Fire

Brecksville, Ohio – On Saturday, June 21, an unoccupied structure in Cuyahoga Valley National Park burned to the ground. The structure, locally known as the Lapchynski house was built in 1880 and is located on Riverview Road in Independence, Ohio. The area is remote since the section of Riverview Road is closed. The house was scheduled for demolition.

Summit County Crime Stoppers will pay up to \$2000 for tips that lead to the arrest and indictment of the persons responsible for the house fire.
