Temporary Towpath Trail Closures in Cuyahoga Valley National Park

Brecksville, Ohio – Sections of the Towpath Trail will be temporarily closed for asphalt resurfacing from Monday, July 27 through Wednesday, July 29, weather permitting. Closures will be in effect from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. according to the schedule below. Towpath Trail closures will be posted with trail signs. If there are rain delays, the schedule will be adjusted as needed.

Monday, July 27

- Stumpy Basin area in Peninsula, south of Boston Store Trailhead between the I-80 bridge and the tunnel 0.5 mile north of Lock 29 Trailhead – Towpath Trail Closed

Tuesday, July 28

- Lock 25 area in Cuyahoga Falls, south from Ira Road to the Conrad Botzum Farmstead driveway – Towpath Trail Closed
- Station Road Bridge area in Brecksville, from Pine Hill Road to the northern Old Carriage Trail junction – Towpath Trail Closed

Wednesday, July 29

- Wilson's Mill area in Valley View, from Fitzwater Bridge to Frazee House – Towpath Trail Closed
- Canal Visitor Center area in Valley View, from Hillside Road to Stone Road bridge – Towpath Trail Closed
