Virginia Kendall Lake Area Reopened to Public *Winter Sports Center Opens December 26*

Brecksville, Ohio – The Virginia Kendall Lake area and the Lake Trail have reopened to the public ahead of schedule. Due to recent beaver activity, hikers need to be cautious of potential hazards on the Lake Trail alongside Truxell Road. National Park Service maintenance staff will make repairs at the beginning of January 2010.

Winter Sports Center will be open on the following dates when there are **at least four inches of snow**: Saturdays and Sundays, December 26 through February 28; and the holidays of January 18 and February 15, 10 a.m. - 4 p.m.

Virginia Kendall Lake area is located at 1000 Kendall Park Road, 2 miles west of Akron Peninsula Road, Peninsula, Ohio 44264.
