Veterans Honored with Free Train Ride on Veterans Day

Discounts Available at Park Place in Peninsula

Peninsula, Ohio – Cuyahoga Valley Scenic Railroad (CVSR) announces a FREE train ride to honor veterans and their families on Wednesday, November 11. The train will depart from Rockside Station at 1 p.m. for a three-hour excursion to Akron and back. Riders can experience the new *Voices in the Valley* audio tour describing the cultural and natural history of Cuyahoga Valley National Park (CVNP). FREE tickets are available at Rockside Station, 45 minutes prior to departure. Tickets are on a first-come, first-served basis. No advanced tickets are available. All current military members, veterans, and their families are invited.
