National Park's Visitor Center Hours for Winter 2009

Brecksville, Ohio - Cuyahoga Valley National Park (CVNP) announces the following hours for park visitor centers for the months of December, January, and February.

Canal Visitor Center, located at 7104 Canal Road, at the intersection of Canal and Hillside Roads, in Valley View 44125, will be open 10 a.m. - 4 p.m., Wednesdays through Sundays. Exhibits illustrate 12,000 years of history in the valley, including the history of the Ohio & Erie Canal.

Boston Store Visitor Center, located at 1548 Boston Mills Road, east of Riverview Road, in Peninsula 44264, will be open 10 a.m. - 4 p.m., daily. This restored structure, built circa 1836, features interactive museum exhibits on canal boat building.

Frazer House, located at 7733 Canal Road in Valley View 44125, is closed for stabilization repairs until further notice.

Hunt Farm Visitor Information Center, located at 2054 Bolanz Road, between Riverview and Akron-Peninsula Roads, in Peninsula 44264 is closed for the winter.

Peninsula Depot Visitor Center, located at 1630 Mill Street, in Peninsula 44264, will be open Saturdays and Sundays, December 5 to 13 and January 9 to February 28, 10 a.m. - 4 p.m. The visitor center is closed December 14 through January 8. This late 19th-century boarding station of the Valley Railway offers basic information and orientation for visitors to the village, park, Cuyahoga Valley Scenic Railroad, and Ohio & Erie Canalway.

Winter Sports Center at Kendall Lake, located at 1000 Truxell Road, 2 miles west of Akron Cleveland Road, Peninsula 44264 will be open Saturdays and Sundays, January 2 through February 28; and the holidays of January 18 (Martin Luther King Day) and February 15 (Presidents' Day), 10 a.m. - 4 p.m., *when there are at least 4 inches of snow*. It may be open additional days during heavy snowfall. The sports center offers the rental of winter equipment, as well as ski and snowshoe instruction.

CVNP encompasses 33,000 acres along the Cuyahoga River between Cleveland and Akron. Managed by the National Park Service, CVNP combines cultural, historical, recreational, and natural activities in one setting.
