Sled Dog Demonstrations

No registration necessary. Arrive at Denali Visitor Center bus stop 40 minutes prior to start time to board the "Dog Demonstration" courtesy bus. No late departures.

Horseshoe Lake Hike - 10:00 am

Daily, starting June 8

Join a ranger for a naturalist walk along the Horseshoe Lake Trail. Walk lasts around 2 hours, and covers about 3 miles round-trip. Walk is easy but for one steep section of trail. Meet at the Denali Visitor Center just before 10:00 am to join.

McKinley Station Walk - 1:00 pm

Daily, starting June 1

Join a ranger for a naturalist walk along the McKinley Station Trail. Walk lasts around 2 hours and covers nearly 1.5 miles. Meet at the Denali Visitor Center just before 1:00 pm to join.

Eielson Stroll - 1:00 pm

Daily, starting June 1

Eielson Visitor Center is located at Mile 66, and is accessible by any Eielson, Wonder Lake or Kantishna shuttle bus. Tickets are available at the Wilderness Cess Center, Mile 0.5

Join a ranger on the Eielson Stroll, a short naturalist walk around Eielson Visitor Center. Select a shuttle bus departing 8:30 am or earlier from the park entrance. No registration is required for the Eielson Stroll. Walk lasts around 45 minutes.

Discovery Hike

Daily, starting June 8

This off-trail, all day hike is a great way to explore Denali. Hikers **must** sign up in person at the Denali Visitor Center one or two days prior to the hike. Hikers must also purchase a \$30.75 Discovery Hike bus ticket. Group size is limited to 11.
