

## Climbing Closure Falcons nesting on the Tower

Routes on the **west face** and **southwest shoulder**, as well as the corresponding **approach routes** and **edges of the Tower summit**. This closure is to protect nesting falcons as well as ensure climber safety. If falcons exhibit defensive behavior, descend at the next safe opportunity and report the incident to park staff.



Closure is between the yellow lines.

Blue circles highlight landmarks on the Tower to help you identify the closed area.

## Rangers strictly enforce all closures

Pursuant to the Code of Federal Regulations, Devils Tower Climbing Management Plan, and the Migratory Bird Treaty Act, all persons are restricted from entering the closed area. **This includes approach routes and passing beneath the closed area.** Use approaches from the north face or Bowling Alley when necessary.
