


CLIMBING CLOSURES

Peregrine falcons are protected by the Migratory Bird Treaty Act under U.S. Code 703-712 and Pursuant to Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations, 1.5(f) and 2.2(a2), and in accordance with the Devils Tower Climbing Management Plan, the following **NORTHEAST BUTTRESS** climbing routes, and the **NORTHEAST EDGES** of the **Tower's Summit**, including **North Face Rappel** are **CLOSED** to protect falcon nesting activity.

Rangers Will Strictly Enforce Closures

Climbers are advised to be aware of territorial aggression from nesting falcons. If falcons exhibit defensive or distressed behavior, descend off of the Tower at the next safe opportunity and report the incident to a ranger or other park employee.

Routes between and including #68 “Belle Fourche Buttress” and #113 “Psychic Turbulence” Are Closed. Failure to comply could result in a fine up to \$5,000 and/or imprisonment up to 6 months.
