# Leave No Trace, Entrance Fees & Park Mission Certifications

### LEAVE NO TRACE

### LEAVE NO TRACE CERTIFICATION

I, \_\_\_\_\_ (PRINT NAME) certify that I have read and understand the Leave No Trace brochure and that I will provide a copy (print or electronic) of this brochure to each person that I bring into Death Valley National Park.

### PARK ENTRANCE FEES

Recreational fees and their use are determined in accordance with the criteria and procedures of the Federal Lands Recreation Enhancement Act of 2004. Death Valley National Park collects entrance fees in accordance with the following chart:

<b>Vehicle Entrance Fee</b>	\$20 for 7 Days—This permit allows all persons traveling with the permit holder in one single private, non-commercial vehicle (car/truck/van) to leave and re-enter the park as many times as they wish during the 7-day period from the date of purchase.	
<b>Individual Entrance Fee</b>	\$10 for 7 Days—This permit allows a single individual traveling on foot, motorcycle, bicycle or as part of an event or guided group that is operating under a Special Use or Commercial Use Permit to leave and re-enter the park as many times as they wish during the 7-day period from the date of purchase. If the motorcycle or bicycle has more than one rider, each rider is charged the \$10 fee.	
<b>Military Annual Pass</b>	Free—for one year to active duty military and dependents only—This permit allows all persons traveling with the permit holder in one single private, non-commercial vehicle (or on foot) to leave and re-enter the park as many times as they wish during the 12 month period from acquisition.	
<b>Death Valley National Park Annual Pass</b>	\$40 for one year—This permit allows all persons traveling with the permit holder in one single private, non-commercial vehicle (or on foot) to leave and re-enter the park as many times as they wish during the 12 month period from the date of purchase.	
<b>Senior Pass</b>	\$10 lifetime—For US citizens who are 62 or older. This permit allows all persons traveling with the permit holder in one single private, non-commercial vehicle (or on foot) to leave and re-enter the park as many times as they wish	
<b>Access Pass</b>	Free lifetime –For US citizens with a permanent disability. This permit allows all persons traveling with the permit holder in one single private, non-commercial vehicle (or on foot) to leave and re-enter the park as many times as they wish.	
<b>Commercial Entrance Fees</b>	Commercial buses and vans with Commercial Use Authorization—Commercial entrance fees are paid for group sightseeing tours with no recreation or participation in an event or guided group operating under a Special Use or Commercial Use Permit. The commercial vehicle brings visitors into the park, they visit various tourist attractions, and leave the park as a group. Entrance Fees for commercial vehicles are based on the capacity of the vehicle per the vehicle capacities listed below:	
	Vehicle capacity 1-6	\$25, plus \$10 per person
	Vehicle capacity 7-15	\$75
	Vehicle capacity 16-25	\$100
	Vehicle capacity 26 or more people	\$200

**PARK ENTRANCE FEES CERTIFICATION**
