YOUTH CONSERVATION CORP RECRUITMENT BULLETIN (YCC-Crew-2010)

Opening Date: March 25, 2010

Position: YCC Crew Member

Salary: \$ 8.00 per hour (or current minimum wage)

Who May Apply: Young Women and Men, ages 15 through 18

Duty Station: Furnace Creek/Cow Creek, Death Valley National Park, California

Death Valley National Park will again operate a Youth Conservation Corp (YCC) program this summer (2010). We expect the program will last eight to nine weeks, beginning approximately June 14, 2010, and ending about August 6, 2010. This is a non-residential program and no housing is available for YCC enrollees. ***Transportation to the duty station will be the responsibility of the enrollee.***

Death Valley National Park is a 3.4-million acre park located in the northern Mojave Desert. Temperatures in Death Valley are hot (120+) and dry in summer, where the duty station is located. Other project locations (for example: Scotty's Castle, Wildrose, Telescope Peak) temperatures' are milder due to higher elevations (3,000 feet and above). Participants will perform hard physical work and may be exposed to insects, adverse weather, and difficult working conditions. Environmental education and a variety of work projects will be part of this year's program which will focus on both group and individual projects, giving participants a variety of working and learning experiences. ***There will be at least one project that will require an overnight campout. Enrollees are expected to participate.***

Who is Eligible: Young men and women, 15 through 18 years of age, who are permanent residents of the United States, its territories or possessions, are eligible for employment without regard to race, color, sex, age, handicap, religion, or national origin. Handicapped youth who can effectively participate in most YCC activities are eligible. Selected applicants must possess a Social Security Card and have a work permit (if required). Youth must have no history of serious criminal or other antisocial behavior that might endanger their safety or that of others. Youth must be willing to work hard and be able to participate in most work projects. Employment is without regard to Civil Service or classification laws, rules, or regulations.

How to Apply: If you are interested in applying for the YCC program, please fill out the attached application form and mail the application to the following address. YCC Applications must be received in the Human Resources Office by the close of business on Monday, May 3, 2010. Human Resources office hours are Monday through Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Hand carried applications must be received by 4:30 p.m. on the closing date to be considered. The Human Resources Office is located directly behind the Visitor Center in the Headquarters Building at Death Valley National Park. The Headquarters Building is located on Highway 190 in the Furnace Creek area. For questions or additional application forms, call (760) 786-3274, 786-3273, or 786-3223.

Selection Process: Candidates may be selected for the YCC Crew by a lottery style process if the number of applications received exceeds the number of positions available. Previous work experience with YCC does not guarantee a position for this upcoming summer season; however, former YCC workers are encouraged to apply if they meet the age requirements for the position. The YCC Crew Members and alternates will be notified the week of May 17, 2010.
