Abstract:

The National Park Service (NPS) has published an Environmental Assessment (EA) to assess the potential consequences of implementing actions in the park's first Fire Management Plan. NPS announces its decision, in accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969, as amended (NEPA), Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) Regulations 40 CFR Parts 1500-1508, NPS Director's Order-12 (DO-12), and the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966, as amended (7-A). The purpose of this Decision Notice and Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) is to communicate clearly consideration by the NPS of all reasonable alternatives, to communicate the NPS rationale for selecting the chosen alternative, to identify any mitigation measures to be implemented as a part of the selected alternative and to explain why the selected action will not have significant effects on the environment.
