Death Valley National Park to Chip-seal Beatty Cutoff Road- Temporary Delays Expected

Starting Tuesday, November 14th, Hardrives Construction will begin chip-sealing 10 miles of the Beatty Cutoff Road (connecting Highway 190 with the Daylight Pass Road) in Death Valley National Park. Paving, sweeping and restriping the 10 miles is expected to take four days and should be completed by Friday November 17, 2006. Delays of 15-20 minutes should be expected. "Visitors will also need to be extra careful with speed during the first few days of this project because of the use and presence of loose gravel," states Superintendent JT Reynolds, "the last thing anyone wants is damage to their vehicles from flying gravel."
