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Business Opportunity Announced for Stovepipe Wells in Death Valley National Park

Death Valley, Ca. - Death Valley National Park Superintendent Sarah Craighead today announced the availability of a Prospectus soliciting proposals for a Concession Contract for providing visitor services at Stovepipe Wells within Death Valley National Park.

This concession contract, which has projected revenue of \$5,000,000 in 2010, will be issued for a term of 10 years and will require operation of lodging, retail, food & beverage, RV campground, service station and other visitor services at Stovepipe Wells. The Prospectus explains the business opportunity and the terms and conditions under which the NPS will award the contract. This business opportunity is being advertised on the Federal Business Opportunities web site, www.fbo.gov.
