
National Parks *In Depth* on the Web

In August of 2006, the web sites of more than 400 units of the National Park System transferred to new servers and a new standardized format. All basic visitor information for each park, such as fees, directions, activities, and hours of operation are now located in the same place on each park website.

In September of 2007, the *In Depth* section of each park's website will come on line, chiefly in the *History & Culture* or the *Nature & Science* sections shown at the left of each web page. On this park's website, *In Depth* materials, including features from back issues of *Spanning the Gap* since 1983, are *already* available. Visitors looking for a particular topic about this park can either browse the *History & Culture* or the *Nature & Science* sections, or can input keywords into the search engine at the top left of every page of the park's website. Visitors who know the year of publication of a particular *Spanning the Gap* feature can also look through the *Park Newspaper-Back Issues* pages of the *News* section.
