



Hurricane Irene Closures



Heavy rains and strong winds passed through the area on August 27 and 28, leaving downed trees, downed power lines, and flood damage. Park maintenance crews are working very hard to clean up and restore the park to normal conditions, but the work will take some time to complete. In addition to protecting park resources, visitor and employee safety is a top priority. No park facility will be re-opened until it is deemed safe for both visitors and employees.

Closures

In New Jersey:

- Old Mine Road (unpaved section) south of the Van Campen Inn
- NPS 615 between Flatbrookville and the Walpack Inn
- Millbrook Village
- Turtle Beach
- Watergate Recreation Site and Upper and Lower Van Campens Glen

In Pennsylvania:

- Dingmans Falls Visitor Center and the Dingmans Falls trail
- George W. Childs Recreation Site
- Adams Creek, Dingmans Falls, and Hornbecks trails
- Conashaugh Horse Trails
- McDade Recreation Trail from Pittman Orchard to Conashaugh

Service Cancellations

Transit in the Park - the weekend bus service provided by the Monroe County Transportation Authority will not operate.

All ranger-led programs are canceled until further notice.



