



Ranger Programs

Ranger-led activities are a great way to discover more about Dinosaur National Monument. All programs are free.

Visitor Center Talk (15 minutes)

Discover what makes Dinosaur such a special place. Talks address a wide variety of topics at the Temporary Visitor Center.

Junior Ranger Activity (15-30 minutes)

Kids discover more about Dinosaur National Monument and their world through hands-on activities and games. Activities developed for children 6 to 12 years old address a wide variety of topics at the Temporary Visitor Center.

Ride with a Ranger (1½ hours)

Enjoy the ride as you discover parts of the Tour of the Tilted Rocks Scenic Drive on a ranger-led shuttle bus tour. Tours begin at the Temporary Visitor Center.

Hog Canyon Hike (1½ hours)

Find a reprieve from the heat in this shaded, spring fed box canyon and discover why Josie Bassett Morris chose to settle in this location. Hike is along a ¾-mile, easy, one-way trail. Meet at the Josie Bassett Morris parking lot (about 20-25 minutes from Temporary Visitor Center).

Viewing Fossils

Journey through millions of years of the earth's history along a self-guided, ¾-mile (one-way) trail. Discover three fossil-bearing layers that illustrate how our planet has changed. A shuttle to the trail-head is available from the Temporary Visitor Center. Rangers are stationed along the trail to provide information and answer questions about the fossils 9:00 to 11:00 am each morning Monday - Friday, and 9:00 to 11:30 am on Saturday and Sunday.


