THE MOLDING OF A LEADER: DWIGHT D. EISENHOWER
Educators' Workshop

A Teacher's Guide and program conducted by park staff have been developed on the theme of character education for grades 4 and 5. The Teacher's Guide includes the following lessons:

- Dwight D. Eisenhower: An Overview
- Defining a Person of Character
- The Development of Character Over Time
- Getting on the Right TRRACC – Ike's Stories
- Defining Responsibility
- President Eisenhower - A Man of Many Hats (site visit or in-class program)
- Stay on the Right TRRACC: Trustworthiness, Respectful, Responsible, Accountable, Caring and Citizenship

This package is free of charge to schools. We recommend participation in a free workshop to be held in the classroom at the Eisenhower National Historic Site on Thursday, November 1, 2012 and Tuesday, March 5, 2013. This is a half-day workshop beginning at 8:30 a.m. and ending at 12:30 p.m. with the time divided between *The Molding of a Leader* curriculum, the *Eisenhower: A Man of Many Hats* site visit, and an in-depth tour of the site.

We will also organize a workshop just for your school district. We will schedule the workshop to meet your needs. We will present it at the Eisenhower National Historic Site or we will present it at your school without the tour component.
