
Closure imposed under the discretionary authority of the Superintendent

In accordance with regulations and the delegated authority provided in Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 1.5, authorized by Title 16, United States Code, Section 3, the following closure is established for the proper management, protection, Government and public use of the portion of Everglades National park under the jurisdiction of the National Park Service.

This discretionary regulation is in addition to the other regulations published in Title 36, CFR, Chapter 1, Parts 2 through 7.

1.5 Closure of Hwy 41 Bridge and surrounding area to airboats

Effective immediately, the areas shaded in green on the attached map will be closed to the launching, operating and use of airboats. Due to environmental damage this closure is being effected to protect critical natural resources and protect sensitive habitat areas.




