



## Campground Regulations

Campsites are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Campsite costs are \$16 per night or \$8 per night for Golden Age/Senior and Golden Access/Access pass-holders. The group campsite costs \$30 per night and is limited to tents only, allowing up to 8 tents and 9-15 people. Water or sewer hook-ups are not available anywhere in the park. (The Flamingo Campground has 41 sites with electrical hookups.) A dump station is located at the head of the campground where fresh water is available. Grills and picnic tables are provided at each site. The campground has restrooms with running water but no showers. You can contact the campground kiosk (Nov. thru Apr.) for information at 305.242.7873.

### Campsites


- Maximum per campsite: eight people and two vehicles; one RV and one tent or two tents.

### Check-out Time

- Check-out time is 12 pm. Register by 10 am.

### Vehicles

- Campground speed limit is 15 MPH. Obey all traffic signs.
- RV's and vehicles must be parked on paved parking areas. An extra vehicle may park on the grassy shoulder, parallel to the road (see diagram below).



### Generator Hours/Quiet Hours

- Generators may be operated from 8 am to 8 pm only.
- Quiet hours are from 10 pm to 6 am.

### Pets

- Pets must be kept on a leash (maximum of 6 feet in length) at all times. Pets are only allowed in the campground, parking lots, and along road-sides. Do not leave pets unattended. Please clean up after your pet.

### Sanitation

- Wastewater drainage of any kind is prohibited. Use the dump station for sewage and gray water disposal.
- Washing of dishes, food, clothing, or other property, and bathing at public water faucets is prohibited. Utility sinks for dish washing are located in the rear of each restroom.
- The use of portable showers is prohibited.
- Hose hook up to faucets is prohibited. Fresh water fill is available at the dump station.

### Campfires

- Fires permitted in grills only. Fires must be attended at all times. Only dead, down wood may be collected.

### Food Storage & Wildlife

- Do not feed or harass any wildlife.
- All food and garbage must be kept sealed in a hard sided container or disposed of properly.
- Do not tie lines or attach anything to the trees for any reason.


### Limitations

- Camping within Everglades National Park is limited to 30 days in a calendar year, with a maximum stay of 14 days during the winter season (Nov. 1 thru Apr. 30).
- Extensions may be granted on a day by day basis. No extensions available when the campground is full.
