Federal Hall is a historic building at 26 Wall Street in the Financial District of Manhattan in New York City. The current Greek Revival–style building, completed in 1842 as the Custom House, is operated by the National Park Service as a national memorial called the Federal Hall National Memorial.

Hours & Location:

The main entrance of Federal Hall is located at 26 Wall Street, near the corner of Wall Street and Nassau Street. The rear entrance, which is wheelchair accessible, is located at 15 Pine Street, near the intersection of Pine Street and Nassau Street. It is highly recommended that all visitors use mass transit when traveling to Federal Hall. Federal Hall is at the center of New York's Financial District. Vehicle traffic is restricted in this area. Mass transit, bicycles, or walking is suggested. Federal Hall NM is open Monday through Friday 9:00AM to 5:00PM.

Reminder: Protective sidewalk scaffolding has been erected around the building to protect the public from falling materials. Later this year, additional scaffolding will be installed while we conduct an in-depth condition assessment of the building facade. Enter the building through the rear on 15 Pine Street.

Admission:

Federal Hall National Memorial does not charge an admission fee. Ranger-lead tours and programs are free of charge.

Tour Requests:

Group tour reservations are not accepted by phone. For groups of 10 or more visitors, please make a request by completing the reservation request form below and e-mailing it through the link on our website.

Group tours are only available Monday through Friday at 11:00AM and 1:00PM.

Group tour reservations must be scheduled at least 2 weeks in advance.

Please note: <u>Group tour requests</u>, <u>do not constitute a reservation</u>. We will make every effort to accommodate your request, but cannot guarantee time availability or staff availability until we respond with a confirmation fax or e-mail. **NOTE:** If your group is late for a scheduled tour, your time will be reduced by the amount of time that your group arrives late.

Confirmation:


