The National Park Service and National Parks of New York Harbor Conservancy are offering special walking tours in lower Manhattan that talk about the unique history of the area. The “New York Freedom Trail” explores New York City’s role in the Revolutionary War. The “New Amsterdam Trail” delves into the city’s earliest years as a Dutch colony. “This Hallowed Ground” reveals the often overlooked contribution of both enslaved and free Africans in the building of early New York.
