3-6 samples, not to exceed a total of 6 pages

3 compositions not to exceed a total of 10 minutes, CD, DVD, or downloadable link
- Performance Artists, Film Makers, and Videographers
3 productions not to exceed a total of 10 minutes, DVD or downloadable link
