



Fire Island 2-day Trek

Cancellation and Refund Policies:

The Superintendent of Fire Island National Seashore reserves the right to cancel the Fire Island Trek at anytime. The Fire Island Trek may be cancelled if, but not limited to, unsafe weather and/or beach conditions. In the event that the park cancels the Fire Island Trek, before the start of the program, a full refund will be issued. An attempt will be made to notify participants at the time of cancellation. Participants may at anytime call the Office of Interpretation at 631-687-4780 with inquiries regarding cancellation.

The Fire Island Trek may proceed pending upcoming inclement weather/poor beach conditions and be subject to cancellation at any point during the program. In the event of a cancellation of a Trek in progress, a partial refund if applicable, will be issued for any fees that would have been applied to the remainder of the program. Participants will be escorted to the nearest Fire Island point of entry. In the case that this be a ferry terminal, participants will be responsible for their own transportation fees and transportation home once back on Long Island. Participants will also be responsible for claiming their "checked in" luggage at Park Headquarters during regular business hours.

Participants may cancel their own reservation at anytime, however two weeks notice, prior to the first day of the Fire Island Trek, is required in order to receive a full refund. No refund will be issued to participants cancelling anytime within two weeks of the start of the program.
