



Fire Island 2-day Trek

Meals, and Lodging:

Thursday, September 5 –

- * **BREAKFAST:** On your own.
- * **LUNCH:** At your own expense - Can be purchased in the communities or bring your own.
- * **SNACK:** Provided** - Upon arrival at the AMC.
- * **DINNER:** Provided** - Will be available at the AMC. All guests are asked to pitch in with the cooking and clean up.
- * **LODGING:** Provided** - At the AMC in Atlantique. The Park has reserved spaces in advance for Trek participants. A shared bathroom and kitchen are available. Sleeping arrangements are bunk beds. Guest are required to provide their own top sheet and pillow case.

Friday, September 6 –

- * **BREAKFAST:** Provided** - A light breakfast will be served at the AMC. All guests are asked to pitch in with the cooking and clean up.

** Included in the price of the Fire Island Trek program.

Transportation:

- * The Fire Island Trek will leave from the Patchogue–Watch Hill ferry at the Patchogue Ferry Terminal in Patchogue, New York on Thursday, September 5 at 10:20 a.m. There is no fee for parking or you can plan to be dropped off. Additionally, there is NO overnight parking at the Fire Island Lighthouse or Robert Moses State Park, so please make arrangements to be picked up on Friday at Field #5 at Robert Moses State Park. Transportation is not offered.
- * If at anytime you can either not participate on both days or the hike is just too much for you, there are ferry services from the island at Davis Park to Patchogue, Cherry Grove, Fire Island Pines, and Sailors Haven to Sayville, or Ocean Beach to Bay Shore Each ferry is operated as a concession at an additional \$10 (*approximate*) cost for the ride. The Fire Island Lighthouse, the final stop of the Fire Island Trek, is accessible by car.
