Celebrate National Public Lands Day during a special canoe paddle along the lee side of Fire Island at Watch Hill. Explore the early fall salt marshes fringing NYS only federally designated wilderness area during this ranger guided canoe tour.

Paddlers must be 16 years or older. 2 paddlers per canoe.

All participants must wear a lifejacket (provided), bring lots of drinking water, sunscreen and hats are recommended.

Plan to be out for 2 hours.
