## for Beginners

(southern end of William Floyd Parkway)



Fire Island is a spectacular place for birds and bird watching, especially during migration time, as migrant songbirds, hawks, and water birds touchdown on the barrier island to rest and feed before continuing their journey south. It's now the peak of the fall migration - a perfect time to learn bird watching tips and techniques and to experience the migration first hand. Practice using binoculars, learn to use a field guide, and how to identify birds in the field by sight and sound.

- \* Dress for the weather and bring binoculars if you have them.
- \* This program includes a presentation and a walk.
