

# FERRY ACCESS for Seasonal Property Owners

Wednesday, November 14<sup>th</sup> through Saturday, November 17<sup>th</sup>

## Purpose:

1. The purpose of your trip to the Island is the removal, from your own home, of medication, clothing, small valuables and jewelry, any important paperwork (including homeowner's insurance policy, and FEMA flood insurance certificate).
2. Use this opportunity to quickly assess storm damage. It is not the time to clean or repair any major structural issues.
3. You should also remove food from your refrigerator and freezer.

## Ferry Departures:

1. Ferries will depart and return from the Bay Shore ferry main terminal. ( See schedule below)

3. You will be charged ferry fare, but there is no charge for parking.

### **Requirements for access to Fire Island:**

1. You will need a copy of your tax bill, current utility bill, or FINS permit with matching photo ID.
2. Only two members per household will be allowed to board the ferry.
3. No one under the age of 16 will be permitted to board the ferry.
4. You cannot board with a pet in Bay Shore, but you can bring, from Fire Island, pets previously left behind.
5. Bring heavy duty garbage bags to clean out your refrigerator.
6. Bring 2 bags or luggage to carry your belongings home. (Don't rely on bags that may be in your house.)
7. NO WAGONS OR CARTS will be permitted either way on the ferry.
8. Bring a camera with you to document any damage, and also remember a flashlight.
9. The ferry company reserves the right to search all bags.
10. Flammable liquids or power tools will not be permitted on the ferry.

### **Safety Issues:**

1. DO NOT REMOVE ANY TAPE OR MARKINGS FROM YOUR HOUSE.
2. There are various sizes and types of debris all over the island. YOU MUST HAVE APPROPRIATE FOOTWEAR, preferably 8 inch high work boots. You are entering a disaster area. Be prepared.
3. Even though there may be running water in your house, do not assume that it is drinkable. You should bring one liter of water per person...and also bring lunch.
4. Your electrical service has been turned off. DO NOT touch any circuit breakers, fuses, or electric of any kind in your home.
5. The propane at your home has been turned off at the tank or your tanks may have been removed by your fire department for safety. Do not attempt to turn on your stove, grill, or heating system.
6. Volunteer Firefighters will be circulating through your community to assist in any way they can.
7. There will be no emergency medical services on Fire Island. You may proceed at your own risk.
