The *Fire Island 2-Day Trek*

Thursday, September 10–Friday, September 11, 2015

- * The Fire Island Trek is approximately a **9 mile hike** on sand and boardwalk beginning at the Fire Island Pines and ending at the Fire Island Lighthouse.
- * Limited logistical support is available, but you must provide and pay for your own transportation and pay for your own meals along the way. You will need to provide your own sleeping bag and bed sheet for the over night stay.
- * There is a \$90.00 fee for lodging and logistical support.

One of only ten National Seashores in the country, Fire Island is truly a unique place. 32 miles long, this barrier island is home to a wilderness area, various barrier island habitats including salt marshes and maritime forest, 17 distinct residential communities, and historical maritime icons like the Fire Island Lighthouse.
