## Summer Seminar Series and Fees

The Friends of Florissant Fossil Beds, Inc. offers one to three day seminars in a variety of geology, biology, humanities, and paleontology courses. The regular fees for each seminar are \$50.00 per person for a one - day seminar, \$65.00 for a two -day, and \$80.00 for a three day seminar. Reduced rates are available for members of the Friends of the Florissant Fossil Beds, Inc (See section on Friends group below). A special rate is available for teachers who join the Friends of the Florissant Fossil Beds and sign up for seminars by May 20, 2008. This can be by phone or mail postmarked by May 20<sup>th</sup>, 2008. This special rate is \$30.00 for a one day, \$40.00 for a two day, and \$50.00 for a three day seminar.

## Teacher Friendly Graduate Credit

Teachers can earn graduate credits through the Division of Extended Studies of Adams State College. Adams State charges \$22.50 for a ½ graduate credit (one - day seminar), and \$45.00 for 1 graduate credit (two - day seminar) and \$67.50 (three day) for 1.5 credits . BOCES recertification credit is available for \$5.00 for ½ credit, and \$10.00 for 1 credit and \$15.00 for 1.5 credits. (No discounts are available for tuition).

## Friends of the Florissant Fossil Beds N.M.

If you join the Friends of the Florissant Fossil Beds, Inc. either as an individual or family, you will receive a \$10.00 discount on the seminar fee. A one - year, individual membership to the Friends is \$15.00 and a one-year, family membership is \$27.00.
