Summer Seminar Series and Fees

The Friends of Florissant Fossil Beds, Inc. offers one day seminars in a variety of geology, biology, humanities, and paleontology courses. The regular fees for each seminar are \$50.00 per person for a one - day seminar. Reduced rates are available for members of the Friends of the Florissant Fossil Beds, Inc (See section on Friends group below). A special rate is available for teachers who join the Friends of the Florissant Fossil Beds and sign up for seminars by June 1, 2010. This can be by phone or mail postmarked by June 1, 2010. Teacher Friendly Graduate Credit

Teachers can earn graduate credit through the Division of Extended Studies of Adams State College. Adams State charges \$27.50 for a ½ graduate credit for a one - day seminar. BOCES recertification credit is available for \$5.00 for ½ credit. (No discounts are available for tuition).
