**Flight 93 National Memorial**

***What's happening at Flight 93 National Memorial?***

A portion of Skyline Road has been permanently closed from the intersection of Lambertsville Road and Skyline Road to the temporary memorial for approximately one mile. "Road Closed" signs are posted on Skyline Road near the intersection with Lambertsville Road, and just to the west of the temporary memorial.

***Why is the closure necessary?***

Skyline Road has deteriorated in places to the point where it is no longer safe for vehicular traffic under certain weather conditions. It is not prudent for the National Park Service to make costly improvements to this section of the road, which will be removed in early 2010 when construction of the first phase of the permanent Memorial begins.


***When?***

The one-mile portion of Skyline Road will be permanently closed to all traffic on December 22, 2009.

***How long will the construction for the first phase of the permanent Memorial last?***

Construction of the first phase of the Memorial will begin in 2010 and continue through the fall of 2011. The ribbon-cutting for this phase and the access road from Route 30 will be on September 11, 2011, the 10-year anniversary of the tragic events of September 11, 2001.

Please maintain a safe distance from the construction site and obey all signage and directions from the security staff, volunteers and rangers. We apologize for any inconvenience that you may experience as a result of the construction project.



***How will this closure affect my visit?***

Visitors will be able to access the temporary memorial from the south/east end of Skyline Road via a detour from Lambertsville Road to Buckstown Road (see the map above). This portion of Skyline Road and the temporary memorial will remain open during initial construction.
