










Instructions


Use the templates provided to construct a scale model of Fossil Butte using a medium (rolled clay, cardboard, styrofoam, etc.) of uniform thickness. The templates can be printed on any size paper by setting paper size in printer preferences. The preferred size is 11"x17".


1. Each template is labeled with its elevation. The 6600' template will serve as the base of your model.
2. Cut each template along the solid line. The dashed line in the interior of the template indicate where the next higher template should be fitted to it.
3. Glue each template to your medium and cut it to that shape.
4. Stack the layers according to elevation using the dashed guidelines to fit the layers together.
5. Papier-mache and paint the model if you wish.
6. Calculate the vertical exaggeration of your model.





