

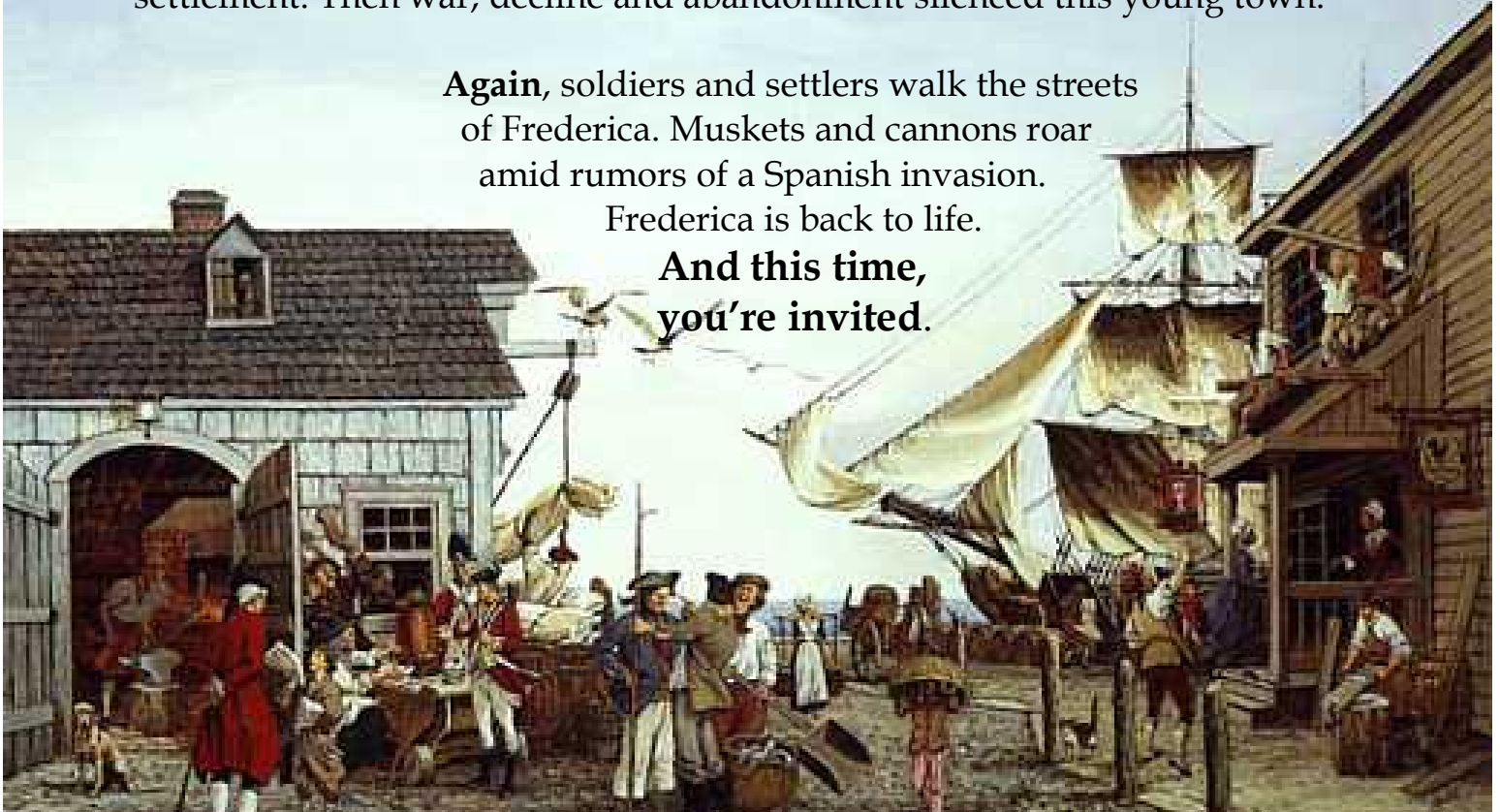
277TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE FOUNDING OF FREDERICA
