The TRT program is a national program that links National Park Service sites to today's classrooms by bringing teachers into the parks to work for the summer and bring their subject matter expertise and educational training to park programs. In exchange, teachers return to the classroom with a new set of experiences to share with their students.

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### TRT at Fort Smith

The historic site is recruiting a teacher (middle or secondary) to assist in the development of education programs that connect the park's history and significance with elementary audiences.

The TRT selected will:

- Develop new distance-education lesson plans with resource materials connecting students to the park's main stories.
- Develop a teacher workshop focused on helping teachers bring the park into their classrooms.
- Evaluate and make recommendations for improving existing programming.

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### TRT at Glance

- A \$3,000 lump sum stipend pending completion of 160 work hours
- Teacher-Ranger-Teacher shirt and hat provided
- Opportunity to earn graduate education credit through the University of Colorado Denver. *Additional requirements apply.*
- Teacher works 160 hours over 4 to 8 weeks between June and August, 2014
- Flexible hours
