Service Description:

This position provides community service organizations such as Cub Scout Packs, Boy Scout Troops, Venturers, etc. an opportunity to complete a project while assisting park staff with large tasks. Depending on the project, the troop may or may not have contact with the public. Any way a group wishes to assist the park will enhance the visitors' experience through completion of their specific project. Depending on availability of space and needs of the park, troops may be invited to spend the night encamped within the facilities.
