(3732) **P___, C.H.** Private. 27 MI. Died May, 1864. Originally buried at Wilderness Battlefield, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(3192) **P___, E.A.M.** Private. US Vol. Died May, 1864. Originally buried at Wilderness Battlefield, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(3984) **P___, J.** Private. US Vol. Died May, 1864. Originally buried at Wilderness Battlefield, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(2964) **P___, W.K.** Private. US Vol. Died May, 1864. Originally buried at Mrs. Downman's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(5042) **Paddock, Hiram** Private. Co.H, 107 NY (FVC has 187). Age - 28. Enlisted at Elmira for three years and mustered into Co.G, 107 NY, 4 Aug., 1862. Died of Typhoid Fever 2 Mar., 1863 at Hope Landing (SR). Originally buried at Hope's Farm, Stafford (ROH).

(1236) **Page, James Golloway** Sergeant. Co.I, 10 PA VRC. Enlisted 17 Jun, 1861 for three years and mustered in 20 Jun, 1861. Re-enlisted 19 Dec., 1863. Promoted from Corporal to Sergeant in Apr., 1864. Died of a gunshot wound in the abdomen received at the Battle of the Wilderness 6 May, 1864 (SR). Originally buried at Wilderness Battlefield, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(1893) **Painter, Michael** Corporal. Co.E, 11 US. Enlisted 10 Jan., 1862 for three years. Died at camp near Potomac Creek of fever 25 Nov, 1862 (NARA). Originally buried at Henry's Farm, Stafford (ROH).

(3213) **Palmer, Edward G. (ROH has S.)** Corporal. Co.A, 143 PA. Enlisted 13 Aug., 1862 at Wilkes Barre for three years. Mustered in 26 Aug., 1862. Killed in action at Laurel Hill 10 May, 1864 at the Spotsylvania Battlefield. Husband of **Sarah Elizabeth Palmer** (NARA). Originally buried at Sanford's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(1697) **Park, William Jr.** Sergeant. Co.D, 12 NJ. Enlisted 11 Aug., 1862 for three years and mustered in 4 Sep, 1862. Died of Typhoid Fever at a hospital near Falmouth 4 Apr., 1863 (SR). Originally buried at Lacey's Farm, Stafford (ROH).

(2249) **Parker, ___.** Private. Co.H, 1 MD H.Art. Died May, 1864. Originally buried at McCoull's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(670) **Parker, T.H.** Private. U.S. Vol. Died May, 1864. Originally buried at Wilderness Battlefield, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(2609) Parkhurst, Charles N. Private. Co.A, 10 NH. Age - 22. Res - Amherst. Born -: Bedford. Enlisted 14 Aug., 1862 and mustered in 20 Aug., 1862. Died of disease 17 Dec., 1862 near Fredericksburg (SR). Originally buried at Primmer's Farm, Stafford (ROH).

(5038) Parks, William Private. Co.C, 107 NY. Age - 21. Enlisted at Elmira for three years and mustered in 18 Jul., 1862. Died of Typhoid Fever 7 Mar., 1863 in camp near Aquia Bay (Reg). Originally buried at Hope's Farm, Stafford (ROH).

(4883) Parks, (SR lists as Parke) William S. Private. Co.I (SR has Co. E), 146 NY Inf. Age - 40 yrs. Enl. 29 Aug., 1862 at Camden to serve three years. Mustered in as Cpl. 10 Oct. Died 10 May, 1864 at Laurel Hill. Originally buried at Sanford's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(3625) Parlin, Herman F. (ROH has Parmer) Private. 2 U.S.S.S., MA. Age - 20. Occ - Trader. Res - Natick. Enlisted and mustered in 4 Jan., 1864. Killed 8 May, 1864 at Laurel Hill (SR). Originally buried at Bibb's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(1369) Parly, E. Private. U.S.A. Originally buried at Couse's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(5234) Parsons, David Private. U.S. Vols. Died 30 Jan., 1863. Originally buried at Tump's Farm, Stafford (ROH).

(1703) Parsons, Henry A. Private. Co.A, 21 CT. Res - Windsor. Mustered in 7 Aug., 1862. Died 20 Dec., 1862 at Fredericksburg (SR). Originally buried at Phillip's Farm, Stafford (ROH).

(3131) Parsons, Joseph L. Private. Co.E, 31 ME. Age - 22. Res - Franklin. Mustered in 11 Mar., 1864. Killed in action 12 May, 1864 (SR). Originally buried at Brown's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(3127) Partridge, George Private. Co.E, 49 NY. Age - 20. Enlisted 9 May, 1861 at Buffalo for two years. Mustered into Co.G, 21 NY, 20 May, 1861. Wounded 30 Aug., 1862 at Bull Run. Mustered out with company 18 May, 1863 at Buffalo. Re-enlisted 27 Jan., 1864 at Buffalo for three years and mustered into Co.E, 49 NY, 30 Jan., 1864. Killed in action 12 May, 1864 at Spotsylvania Court House (SR). Originally buried at Brown's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH). One of two buried here: other name is **Phillip Moriarty**. Both men died on the same day in the same place. Name also appears on the monument on the battlefield.

(5326) Paup, George W. Sergeant. Co.G, 155 PA. Enlisted 26 Jul., 1862 at Clarion for three years. Mustered in as a Corporal 2 Sept., 1862. Died of Typhoid Fever 8, 9, or 21 Dec, 1862 near Falmouth (SR). Originally buried at Robert Smith's Farm, Stafford (ROH).

(6080) Paxton, Thomas Sergeant. Co.D, 39 PA. Age - 22. Occ - Butcher. Enlisted 21 Jul., 1861 at Harrisburg for three years. Mustered in as a Corporal 21 Jul., 1861. Promoted to Sergeant 7 Jul., 1862. Died 10 May, 1864 of wounds received at the Battle of the Wilderness 8 May, 1864 (NARA). Originally buried at Laurel Hill Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(681) Payton, John William Private. Co.F, 17 IN. Occ - Farm Laborer. Enlisted 1 Dec., 1863 at Franklin for three years and mustered in 2 Dec., 1863. Wounded 5 May, 1864 at the Wilderness and admitted to 4th Div. 5th Corps field hospital 6 May, 1864 for treatment of wounds to cranial bones. Died of wounds 18 May, 1864 (SR). Originally buried at Woolen Factory Lot, Fredericksburg (ROH).

(4932) Peace, Gogswell J.(ROH has Pice & SR has Cogswell J. Place) Private. Co.A, 12 NH. Res - Alton. Enlisted 13 Aug., 1862 and mustered in 30 Aug. 1862. Wounded 3 May, 1863 at Chancellorsville. Died of wounds 5 Jun, 1863 (SR). Originally buried at Douglas's Farm, Stafford (ROH).

(4103) Pearson, Henry H. Lieutenant Colonel. 6 NH. Age - 22. Res - Exeter. Born - Newport, Ill. Enlisted and mustered into Co.C, 6 MA Vol. Militia 22 Apr., 1861 for three months. Mustered out 2 Aug., 1861. Appointed Captain 30 Nov., 1861 and mustered into Co.C, 6 NH, 27 Nov., 1861. Wounded 29 Aug., 1862 at Bull Run. Appointed Lieutenant Colonel 15 Oct., 1862. Killed 26 May, 1864 at North Anna River (SR). Originally buried at Thomas Chandler's Farm, North Anna River (ROH).

(1129) Pearsons, William Lieutenant. 4 NY. Age - 28. Enlisted 23 Apr., 1861 at New York City. Mustered in as a Sergeant, Co.C, 2 May, 1861 for two years. Promoted First Sergeant 20 Jun, 1861. Reduced to Sergeant (no date). Promoted to Sergeant Major 2 Jul., 1862. Mustered in as Second Lieutenant, Co.D, 26 Oct., 1862, and commissioned 10 Nov, 1863 with rank from 7 Jul., 1863. Died 1 Jan., 1864 at Falmouth (SR). Originally buried at O'Bannon's Farm, Stafford (ROH).

(5067) Peck, ____. Private. NY. Died 1 Dec., 1862. Originally buried at Streshley's Farm, Stafford (ROH).

(3094) Peer, A.K. Private. US Vol. Died May, 1864. Originally buried at Beverly's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(6087) Peifer, Samuel (ROH has Piffer) Private. Co.F, 93 PA. Died 13 May, 1864. Originally buried at Laurel Hill Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(5127) Pelan, R.F. Private. U.S. Vol. Died 1862. Originally buried at Streshley's Farm, Stafford (ROH).

(1266) Pember, Jared T. Private. Co.E, 8 CT. Res - Franklin. Mustered in 25 Sept., 1861. Died 9 Aug., 1862 at Falmouth (SR). Originally buried at Bernard's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(6020) Pender, Oren S. Private. Co.H, 157 NY. Age 20. Enlisted 22 Aug., 1862 at Homer for three years. Mustered in as a Private 19 Sept., 1862. Died of chronic diahrea 5 Mar., 1863 at Aquia Creek (SR). Originally buried at Cliff's Farm, Stafford (ROH).

(6689) Pepmeier, Harold J. Private. Batt. E, 62 Coast Art. Died 8 Jan., 1926.

(1980) Pepoon, Porteus Private. Co.E, 12 NJ. Enlisted 16 Aug., 1862 for three years and mustered in 4 Sept., 1862. Killed in action at Spotsylvania Court House 12 May, 1864 (SR). Originally buried at Laurel Hill Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(3001) Pepper, M. Private. Co.K, 2 U.S.A. Died 10 May, 1864. Originally buried at Sanford's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(601) Percival, Addison C. Sergeant. Co. M, 1 ME H.Art. Age - 19. Res - Hudson. Mustered in as Corporal Co.B, 1 ME H. Art. Promoted to Sergeant. Killed 19 May, 1864 (Reg). Originally buried at Allsop's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(5174) Perdue, Caeser Private. Co.D, 122 NY. Age - 44. Enlisted at Syracuse for three years and mustered in 20 Aug., 1862. Died 28 Dec., 1862 at camp near Fredericksburg (Reg). Originally buried at Robinson's Farm, Stafford (ROH).

(4074) Perkins, William B. Private. Co.D, 9 NH. Age -40. Res - Conway. Born - Conway. Enlisted and mustered in 31 Dec., 1863 for three years. Killed 12 May, 1864 at Spotsylvania (SR). Originally buried at Beverly's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(1003) Perrine, Richard Private. Co.G, 145 NY. Age - 18. Enlisted 29 Aug., 1862 at Staten Island for three years and mustered in 11 Sept., 1862. Died of Typhoid Fever 12 Apr., 1863 at a regimental hospital (SR). Originally buried at J.M. Stewart's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(599) Perry, Adolphus E. Private. Co.F, 118 NY. Age - 23. Enlisted 9 Aug., 1862 at Essex for three years. Mustered in 29 Aug., 1862. Died of Typhoid Fever 10 Mar., 1863 at hospital camp, Adirondack, D.C. (SR). Originally buried at Allsop's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(4751) Perry, Daniel Private. Co.I, 16 ME. Age - 36. Res - Minot. Mustered in 14 Aug., 1862. Killed 28 Mar., 1863 (SR). Originally buried at Fletcher Chapel Lot, George (ROH).

(4835) Perry, John W. Private. Co.G, 17 ME. Age - 19. Enlisted 31 Jul, 1862 at Salem for three years. Mustered in 18 Aug., 1862 at Portland. Died at a hospital near Fredericksburg 11 Dec., 1862 of Typhoid Fever (SR). Originally buried at Henry's Farm, Stafford (ROH).

(1107) Persons, William W. Private. Co.K, 73 OH. Age - 36. Enlisted 22 Aug., 1862 for three years. Died 12 Jan., 1863 at Falmouth (SR). Originally buried at Bernard's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(4519) Peters, John Private. 81 PA. Died, May, 1864. Originally buried at Fountain's Farm, North Anna River (ROH).

(6705) Peters, Landon B. Private. 21 Tank Maint.Mo. Enlisted 10. Dec., 1920. Discharged 1 Dec. 1921. Died 5 Jan., 1933.

(5919) Peterson, Carl Private. Co.C, 31 NY. Age - 26. Enlisted 2 May, 1861 at New York city for two years and mustered in 27 May, 1861. Died 11 Apr., 1863 at camp near Belle Plain (committed suicide) (SR). Originally buried at Salvington Farm, Stafford (ROH).

(5133) Peterson, Franklin Private. Co.K, 4 US Art. Died 10 Apr., 1863. Originally buried at Fitzhugh's Farm, Stafford (ROH).

(3847) Peterson, H. Private. 14 OH. Died May, 1864. Originally buried at Brown's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(4690) Peterson, William Private. Co. B, 25 NJ. Enlisted 1 Sept., 1862. Mustered-in 26 Sept., 1862 for 9 months. Died of Typhoid Fever at a regimental hospital near Falmouth, 11 Jan., 1863 (SR). Originally buried at Phillip's Farm, Stafford (ROH).

(2953) Peterson, William H. Private. Co.G, 64 NY. Age - 18. Enlisted at Ridgebury for three years. Mustered in 18 Nov., 1861. Wounded in action 1 Jun., 1862 at Fair Oaks. Discharged for his wounds 16 Aug., 1862 in Philidelphia. Enlisted 8 Oct., 1862 at Ithica for three years and mustered in

16 Oct., 1862. Promoted Corporal 17 Oct, 1862. Killed in action 3 May, 1863 at Chancellorsville (SR). Originally buried at Ely's Ford, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(5989) Phelps, Clark Private. Co.E, 149 NY. Enlisted 27 Aug., 1862 at Pompey for three years and mustered in 18 Sept., 1862. Taken to a regimental hospital 14 Feb., 1863, with a complaint of Typhus. Transferred to 12 Army Corps Hospital, Aquia Creek, 7 Mar., 1863. Died of Typhoid Fever 10 Mar., 1863 (NARA and HR). Originally buried at Marlboro Point, Stafford (ROH).

(3074) Phelps, Francis J. (Broadfoot has same & Reg has Philips, Franklin J.) Corporal. Co.E, 49 PA. Age - 28. Res - Westchester. Enlisted 10 Sept., 1861 for three years and mustered into Co.B. Promoted Corporal 1 Oct., 1862. Transferred to Co.E, 4 Dec., 1863. Re-enlisted 29 Feb., 1864. Killed at the Wilderness or Spotsylvania 5 May, 1864 (SR). Originally buried at Wilderness Battlefield, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(4275) Philbrick, John H. (see Pilbrick, John H.)

(4907) Phillips, Davis N. Private. Co. F, 141 PA. Age - 40. Enlisted in Lathrop Township. Died at Division Hospital of Typhoid Fever, 13 Dec., 1862 (REG). Originally buried at Roy's Farm, Stafford (ROH).

(5723) Phillips, George Private. Co. B, 137 NY. Age - 22. Enlisted 2 Aug., 1862 at Windsor for three years. Mustered in 9 Aug., 1862. Died 24 Feb., 1863 at Aquia Creek (SR). Originally buried at Marlboro Point, Stafford (ROH).

(2662) Phillips, Lorenzo Private. US Vol. Died May, 1864. Originally buried at Woolen Factory Lot, Fredericksburg (ROH).

(3702) Phillips, Theodore F. Sergeant. Co.G, 1 NJ. Enlisted 23 May, 1861 for three years and mustered in 28 May, 1861. Promoted Corporal 1 Sept., 1862 and to Sergeant 4 Apr., 1863. Killed in action at the Wilderness 6 May, 1864 1 Sept., 1864 (SR). Originally buried at Wilderness Battlefield, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(1853) Pierce, Alonzo F. Private. Co.B, 13 NH. Age - 18. Res - Antrim. Born - Bennington. Enlisted 22 Aug., 1862 and mustered in 18 Sept., 1862. Died of disease 5 Jan., 1863 at Falmouth (SR). Originally buried at Phillip's Farm, Stafford (ROH).

(4703) Pierce, George W. Private. Co. A, 17 ME. Age - 36. Occ - Currier. Born - South Berwick. Mustered 18 Aug., 1862. Drowned near Falmouth 26 Dec., 1862 (Reg). Originally buried at Little's Farm, Stafford (SR).

(540) Pierce, Jerome Corporal. Co.H, 36 MA. Age - 31. Occ - Mechanic. Res - Orange. Enlisted 4 Aug., 1862 and mustered in 27 Aug., 1862. Killed 12 May, 1864 at the battle of the Bloody Angle at Spotsylvania. After his death, his family sent \$100 to the Supt.of the Cemetery and asked him to decorate the grave regularly. The Supt. opened an account in the Farmers and Merchants Bank of Fredericksburg. The Supt. enlisted the help of his own family to keep the grave decorated. **Alice Heflin Abernathy** continued to do as her grandfather in decorating the grave.The original account is still in a local bank and shows small withdrawals over the years. The balance now stands at \$173. Her 11 year old grandnephew assumed the decorating of the grave.The grandnephew continues to see to is that the grave is decorated. **Jerome Pierce** was originally buried at McCoull's Farm,Spotsylvania (ROH).

(1985) Pierce, Silas E. Lieutenant. Co.F, 121 NY. Age - 18. Enlisted 12 Aug., 1862 at Middlefield for three years. Mustered in as a Private, Co.E, 23 Aug., 1862. Promoted Corporal and Sergeant (no dates). Mustered in as Second Lieutenant, Co. F, 10 Apr, 1863, and as First Lieutenant 10 Apr., 1864. Wounded in action 12 May, 1864 at Spotsylvania and died 13 May, 1864 (SR). Originally buried at Laurel Hill Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(6134) Pierson, Wellington Corporal. Co.D, 1 NJ. Enlisted 8 May, 1861 for three years and mustered in 22 May, 1861. Promoted Corporal 1 Sept., 1862. Died of fever at White Oak Church 3 Mar., 1863 (SR). Originally buried at White Oak Church, Stafford (ROH).

(6087) Piffer, Samuel (see Peifer, Samuel)

(4275) Pilbrick, John H. Private. Co.E, 11 NH. Age - 43. Res - Alton. Born - Epsom. Enlisted and mustered in 18 Jan., 1864. Killed at Spotsylvania 16 May, 1864 (SR). Originally buried at Beverly's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(5144) Pinkham, Otis W. Private. US Vol. Became ill at Brooks Station and sent to the Division Hospital on April 27th. Died of disease May 15, 1863. Originally buried at Brook's Farm, Stafford.

(5521) Pixley, Francis A. Private. Co.A, 55 OH. Age - 20. Enlisted 11 Aug., 1862 for three years. Died 28 Mar., 1863 at Brooks' Station (SR). Originally buried at Sullivan's Farm, Stafford (ROH).

(2742) Platts, Edward M. Corporal. 5 MA Lt. Art. Age - 18. Occ - Clerk. Res - Boston. Enlisted 29 Sept., 1861 and mustered in as a Private 3 Dec., 1861. Wounded in left breast 13 Dec., 1862 at Fredericksburg and admitted to 1st Div. 5th Corps Hospital near Falmouth. Died of wounds 14 Dec., 1862 (SR and HR). Originally buried at Rever's Lot, Fredericksburg (ROH).

(3531) Plead, Austin Private. Co.B, 17 VT. Age - 21. Res - St. Albans. Enlisted 4 Feb., 1864 and mustered into Co.D, 3 Mar., 1864. Killed in action at the Wilderness 6 May, 1864 (SR). Not in ROH.

(775) Plumer, Asa (ROH has Plimer, A.S.A.) Private. Co.C, 19 ME. Age - 22. Res - Augusta. Mustered in 5 Aug., 1863. Killed in action at Spotsylvania 12 May, 1864 (Reg). Originally buried at Laurel Hill, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(2429) Poe, Thomas Ballard Private. Co.A, 8 MD. Enlisted and mustered in 13 Aug., 1862 at Ball for three years. Died in hospital of gunshot wound received at the Wilderness 18 May, 1864. Husband of **Anna Eliza Thomas** (NARA). Originally buried at Woolen Factory Lot, Fredericksburg (ROH).

(3039) Pollock, Abram M. Private. Co.H, 126 OH. Age - 18. Enlisted 14 Aug., 1862 for three years. Killed in the Battle of Spotsylvania 12 May, 1864 (SR). Originally buried at McCoull's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH). Note: one of three persons listed for this grave - others buried there are **A.Arnold and Thomas Harvey or Hervey** Name appears on the monument on the battlefield.

(5682) Pomroy, William R. Corporal. Co.B, 1 ME. Occ - Nailer. Enlisted 1 May, 1861 at Pembroke and mustered in 15 Jul., 1861. Wounded 3 May, 1863 at Fredericksburg and died 29 May, 1863 at the 6th Corps Hospital, at Potomac Creek of a gunshot wound which caused a compound fracture to the right arm (NARA). Originally buried at Green's Farm, Stafford (ROH).

(4676E) Poole, William Corporal. Co.D, 545 Eng. Enlisted 30, Aug.1918. Discharged 5 July, 1919. Died 18 Oct, 1933.

(6047) Pooler, John M. Private. 1 MA Art. Age - 24. Occ - Blacksmith. Res - Canton. Enlisted and mustered in 28 Aug, 1861. Died 14 Mar, 1863 of disease at White Oak Church (SR). Mentioned in Story of 1st Mass. Lt. Battery p. 99, by J. Bennett. Originally buried at White Oak Church, Stafford (ROH).

(1205) Poor, Harlan A. (ROH has Pool) Private. Co.D, 17 MI. Age 18. Res - Johnstown. Enlisted 22 Jul, 1862 at Kalamazoo for three years and mustered in 11 Aug, 1862. Killed in Action at Spotsylvania 12 May, 1864 (SR). Originally buried at Beverly's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH)

(1802) Pope, F.H. Private. Co.B, 15 MA Possibly same as:**Pope, Horace T.** Private. Co.B, 15 MA. Age - 23. Occ - Machinist. Res - Boston. Enlisted and mustered in 12 Jul, 1861. Died 15 May, 1864 of wounds received 10 May, 1864 at Spotsylvania (SR). Originally buried at Masonic Cemetery, Fredericksburg (ROH).

(1219) Pope, J.C. Private. Co.A, 23 NY (name not in SR). Died May 1862. Originally buried at Fitzhugh's Farm, Stafford (ROH). Possibly same as **Pope, John W.** Private. Co.A, 28 NY. Age - 19. Occ - Farmer/ Laborer. Enlisted 27 Aug, 1862 at Freehold for nine months. Died 12 Mar, 1863 at 3rd Div. 2nd Corps Hospital near Falmouth of Typhoid Fever (NARA).

(2349) Portwine, George Private. Co.F, 1 U.S.S.S. Age - 19. Occ - Farmer. Born - Middlebury, VT. Enlisted 11 Sept, 1862 at Rutland, VT for three years and mustered in 20 Sept, 1862. Died in camp near Falmouth 23 Mar, 1863 of Typhoid Fever (SR). Originally buried at Primmer's Farm, Stafford (ROH).

(5979) Potter, Abram G. Private. Co.A, 151 PA. Enlisted 15 Sept, 1862 at Susquehanna Co. for nine months and mustered in 17 Oct, 1862. Admitted to 3rd Div, 1st Army Corps Hosp, Aquia Creek 28 Apr, 1863 of Typhoid Fever and died 19 May, 1863 (SR). Originally buried at Marlboro Point, Stafford (ROH).

(2444) Potter, Allen Private. Co. I, 4 OH. Age - 25. Enlisted 5 Jun, 1861 for three years. Killed in battle of Potomac River 10 May, 1864 (SR). Originally buried at McCoull's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(3525) Potter, William W. Private. Co.I, 17 MI. Age - 23. Res - Kalamazoo. Enlisted as a Corporal 2 Aug, 1862 for three years and mustered in 16 Aug, 1862. Died of disease at Falmouth 27 Dec, 1862 (SR). Originally buried at A.Wallace's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH. Unlikely burial place given the location of death - possibly typo in ROH?)

(5993) Potters, George Private. 1 MA H.Art. Died 20 May, 1864. Originally buried at Goolrick's Farm, Fredericksburg (ROH).

(6146) Pottinger, David R. Private. Co.D, 20 PA Cav. Age - 19. Occ - Saddler. Born - Dauphin. Enlisted 8 Feb, 1864 at Harrisburg for three years and mustered in 18 Feb, 1864. Muster rolls state he died 20 May, 1865 at a field hospital of disease (NARA), while SR state he died 12 May, 1865 at Regimental Hospital, 3rd Div. 9th Corps, of inflammation of the stomach. FVC has date of death as 11 May, 1865. Originally buried in Stafford Co. (ROH).

(5399) Potts, F.A. Private. Co.B, 5th PA Reserves. Grave marker says Tenn. Mustered in 21 June 1862. Wounded at Fredericksburg 13 December 1862. Died 18 December 1862. Originally buried at Morrison's Farm, Stafford (ROH).

(6129) Powell, Edwin A. Private. Co.F, 21 NJ. Enlisted 23 Aug, 1862 for nine months and mustered in 15 Sept, 1862. Died of Typhoid Fever at camp near White Oak Church 16 Mar, 1863 (SR). Originally buried at Robert Lee's Farm, Stafford (ROH).

(823) Powell, John Sergeant. Co.A, 1 NY M.R. Age - 22. Born - Columbia Co. Enlisted 17 Jul, 1861 at New York City for three years. Mustered in as a Private 31 Aug, 1861 at Fort Monroe, VA. Mustered out 31 Dec, 1863, discharged by virtue of re-enlistment as a veteran volunteer. Re-enlisted 1 Jan, 1864. Discharged by expiration of service 4 Feb, 1864. Mustered in as a veteran volunteer. Promoted to Corporal 1 Aug, 1864 and to Sergeant 1 Jul, 1865. Died at Union Wharf 22 Aug, 1865 of congestive fever (NARA). Originally buried at Union Wharf, Richmond (ROH).

(3369) Powell, John Private. Co.B, 27 MI. Died May, 1864. Originally buried at Wilderness Battlefield, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(6031) Powers, Frank Private. Co.D, 1 ME H.Art. Age - 18. Res - Bangor. Mustered in 15 Apr, 1863. Died 8 Aug, 1864 of wounds received 18 Jun, 1864 (Reg). FVC has date of death as May, 1864. Originally buried at Goolrick's Farm, Fredericksburg (ROH).

(1655) Powers, William Private. Co.I, 17 ME. Age - 19. Occ - Farmer. Res - Gorham. Born - Boston. Mustered in 18 Aug, 1862. Died of Typhoid Fever 11 Jan, 1863 at Camp Pitcher (Reg). Originally buried at Mackey's Farm, Stafford (ROH).

(5356) Prall, John Private. Co.D, 30 NJ. Enlisted 3 Sept, 1862 at Flemington for nine months. Died 14 Jan, 1863 of camp fever at Aquia Creek. Son of **Uriah and Catherine Prall** (NARA). Originally buried at Tump's Farm, Stafford (ROH).

(5368) Price, S. Private. U.S. Vol. Died 1863. Originally buried at Marlboro Point, Stafford (ROH).

(1017) Prichard, Gaines Sergeant. Co.D, 143 PA. Enlisted 6 Aug, 1862 at Kingston for three years. Mustered in as a Corporal 6 Sept, 1862 at Wilkes Barre. Died 26 May, 1864 at Port Royal of wounds. Husband of Amy Beihan (NARA). Originally buried at Port Royal, Caroline (ROH).

(3307) Prior, George Private. 6 OH. Died May 1864. Originally buried at Mitchell's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(4796) Prior, William Corporal. Co.I, 6 VT. Age - 31. Res - Essex. Enlisted 9 Sept, 1861 and mustered in 15 Oct, 1861. Died 26 or 27 Dec, 1862 of disease (SR). Originally buried at Ball's Farm, Stafford (ROH).

(6697) Proctor, John B. Art. Officer. Co.K, 3 Inf. Died 27 Jul, 1930.

(499) Proudfit, Francis M. Private/ Teamster. Co.G, 10 PA VRC/39 PA. Age - 18. Occ - Cooper. Born - Erie Co. Enlisted 21 Jul, 1861 at Harrisburg for three years and mustered in 21 Jul, 1861. Mustered out 18 Dec, 1863. Re-enlisted as a veteran volunteer 19 Dec, 1863 for three years. Promoted to Teamster 12 Dec, 1863 and to Wagoner 1 Jan, 1864. Killed in action 8 May, 1864 at the Wilderness or Spotsylvania Court House (NARA). Originally buried at Laurel Hill, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(5926) Prow, G.W. Private. Co.H, 43 NY. Originally buried at Salvington Farm, Stafford (ROH).

(3000) Pruyn, Howard F. 1st Lieutenant. Co.A, 6 WI. Res - Baraboo. Enlisted 10 May, 1861 and mustered in as a Sergeant. Promoted to Second Lieutenant 9 Oct, 1862. Wounded at Gettysburg. Killed in action 8 May, 1864 at Laurel Hill (SR). Originally buried at Sanford's Farm, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(2189) Puffer, Henry C. Sergeant. Co.G, 21 MA. Age - 25. Occ - Carpenter. Res - Ashburnham. Enlisted and mustered 19 Jul, 1861. Re-enlisted 1 Jan, 1864 as a Sergeant. Wounded 12 May, 1864 at Spotsylvania and died of the same wounds 14 May, 1864 (SR). Originally buried at Marye's Heights, Fredericksburg (ROH).

(6737) Purcell, Alexandria Private. Co.C, 3 Inf. Died 26 Feb, 1939.

(4569) Purdy, George H. Captain. 82 OH. Age - 28. Enlisted 1 Nov, 1861 for three years and mustered into Co.I, 82 OH. Appointed Captain 21 Dec, 1861. Wounded 8 May, 1862 in the battle of McDowell. Killed 2 May, 1863 at Chancellorsville (SR). Originally buried at Wilderness Dale, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(3700) Putnam, Joseph Corporal. Co.F, 16 MI. Age - 18. Res - Nankin. Enlisted and mustered in 9 Sept, 1861. Re-enlisted 21 Dec, 1863 at Rappahannock Station and mustered in as a Corporal 22 Dec, 1863. Killed at the Wilderness 6 May, 1864 (SR). Originally buried at Wilderness Battlefield, Spotsylvania (ROH).

(2588) Putney, L.D. Private. Co.C, 12 NH. Possibly same as **Putney, Daniel S.** Private. Co.C, 12 NH. Age - 40. Res - Hebron. Enlisted 22 Aug, 1862 and mustered in 5 Sept, 1862. Died 14 Jan, 1863 at Falmouth (SR). Originally buried at Primmer's Farm, Stafford (ROH).
