



# Volunteer Job Summary

**Title:** Campground Host

**Location:** Gateway National Recreation Area- Sandy Hook

## Skills Required:

- Demonstrates strong interpersonal skills
- Has a high level of comfort with speaking to strangers
- Is able to engage visitors
- Is able to clearly answer questions and give directions
- Be comfortable communicating with dispatch on a two-way radio
- Is comfortable being outdoor 32 hours a day in high temperatures and high humidity
- Familiar with camping and can answer basic camping knowledge questions that visitors will ask
- First Aid Certified (Training may be provided)

## Job Responsibilities:

In this position, the volunteer will

- -Work 32 hours a week
- - Greet campground visitors, inform them of campground rules and regulations and seek voluntary compliance with those regulations. Provide information and assistance, if needed.
- - Alert campers to any restrictions that are in effect.
- - Inform campers in campsites of fee regulations for both parking fees and camping fees. If there are problems or issues, contact a law enforcement ranger.
- - Monitor camper activity to ensure rules are being followed. If there is any suspicious, unusual persons, situations, violations and/or emergencies report them to Law Enforcement immediately.
- Answering questions about the site
- Supporting the Park Service staff, as needed

## Special Notes:

A VIP uniform must be worn while performing this position. This is an outdoor position.
