

General Agreement

The Stillman project is intended to be completed in **phases** to:

- Provide certainty that the project is feasible based on the outcomes of the first phase, which requires the development of two prototypes
- Allow for the development of a comprehensive concept plan
- Ensure SDI has the financial capability necessary to complete the project as anticipated


