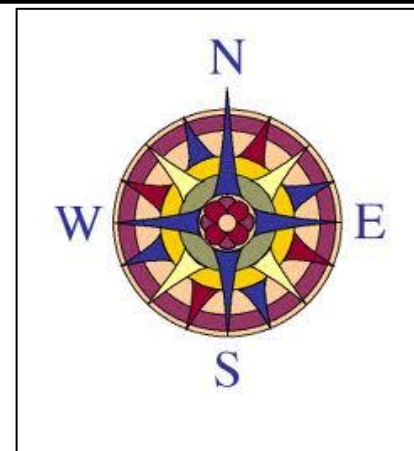




Site 01: Floyd Bennett Field Ranger Station

At this site you can get information about the Jamaica Bay Unit of Gateway National Recreation Area. Floyd Bennett Field was the first Municipal Airport, the site of many historic flights and one of the most vital Naval Air-stations in the United States during World War II. Today you can enjoy a host of recreational activities, as well as steep yourself in the natural and cultural history of the site. Your journey begins here at the Ranger Station, which served as a support building for the guard booth you see in the middle of the entrance adjacent. When you have completed the Geocaching Packet, bring it back here to the Ranger Station to check your answers and get your Commemorative Pin – You've earned It!

Visit Instructions: Each building built on Floyd Bennett Field, no matter how small, was given a number, in the order in which the building was built. Take a look at this entrance building and note the building # on its side. This is the first answer in your search.
