The General Grant National Memorial is honored to be a part of the Open House New York Weekend!

- Special night-time tours of the memorial will be offered at 6, 7, and 8 pm on Sunday, October 16, exclusive to Open House New York. Reservations will only be accepted through <http://www.ohny.org/>
- Ranger-led outdoor walking tours begin at the visitor center at 11:15, 1:15, and 3:15, and last about 45 minutes.

The final resting place of Ulysses S. Grant and his wife Julia is the largest mausoleum in North America. It testifies to a people's gratitude for the man who ended the Civil War as Commanding General of the Union Army and then, as President of the United States, strove to heal the nation.

The memorial is located at Riverside Drive and 122nd Street in northwest Manhattan. The visitor center is to the west, across south-bound Riverside Drive.

General Grant National Memorial is open 9 am to 5 pm, Wednesday through Sunday.
