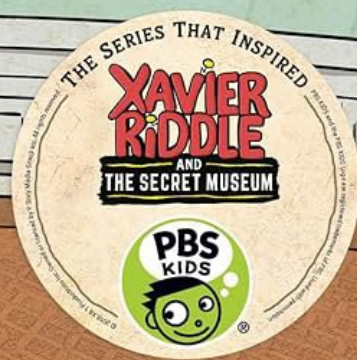
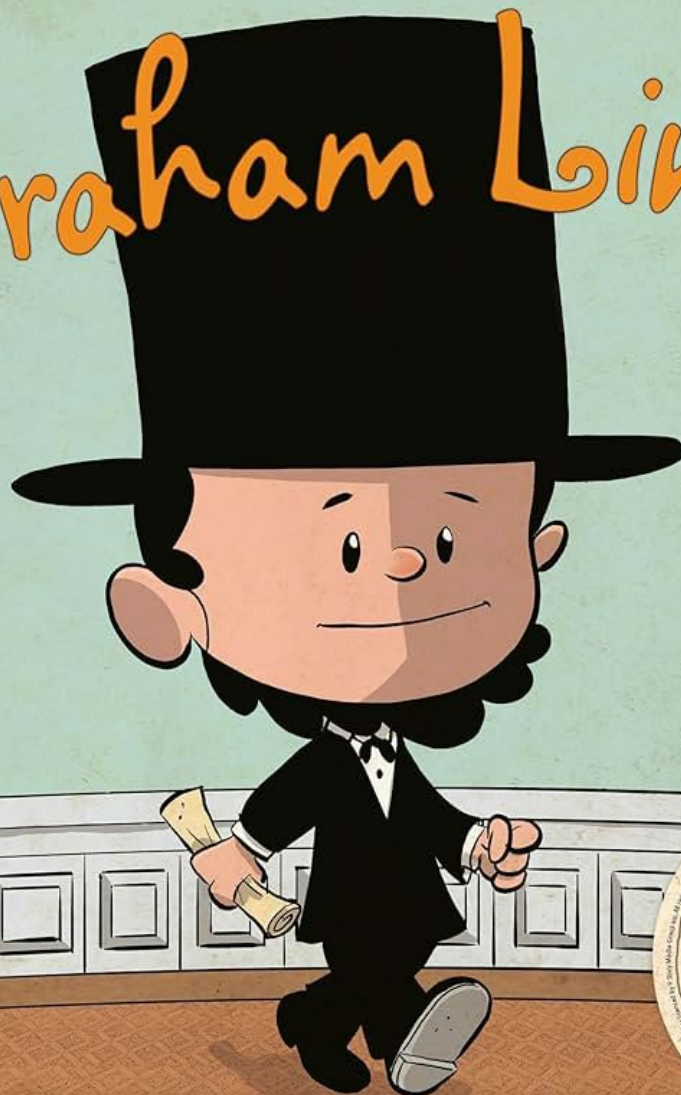

New Book Words

AUTHOR

is the writer of the book.

ILLUSTRATOR

is the person who created the pictures for the book.

SETTING

is the time and place of the story.

CHARACTERS

are the people or creatures in a story that speak and perform the actions. The MAIN character is who the book is about!

FICTION

is made-up stories from the author's imagination.

NON-FICTION

is writing about real people, places and events.

PLOT

is the series of events that make up the story.

CONFLICT

is the main problem or struggle in the story.
