Want your students to learn directly from primary sources, and from the fields of battle themselves, but cannot get them to Gettysburg? Our new Virtual Field Trips offer three continuous opportunities for learning right from your classroom:

- 1.** Class registration (below) gives you access to the trip website, with primary sources and lessons that prepare your students for their "trip".
- 2.** Tune into the 20-30 minute virtual experience (on March 5 or March 12) to come along on the battlefield and use the primary sources to piece together the experiences of those involved in, or affected by, the battle of Gettysburg.
- 3.** The next day (March 6 or March 13), park rangers will be on-line throughout the school day to answer your students' questions, and lead discussions.
