On Saturday April 20 from 10-4, George Washington Birthplace National Monument will be celebrating National Junior Ranger Day with living history demonstrations and colonial activities suitable for the whole family. Scheduled to date are outdoor games and surveying (George Washington style), spinning and hearth cooking demonstrations.

Hosting the day's activities will be the park's own George Washington Birthplace National Monument 4-H Heritage Club.

This event kicks off National Park Week which is being celebrated throughout the country from April 20-28.

As always, visitors from 6-12 will be given an opportunity to complete the park's Junior Ranger Handbook and earn a Junior Ranger Badge.

George Washington Birthplace National Monument is located on Route 204, 2 miles off of Route 3, 38 miles east of Fredericksburg, VA and 11 miles west of Montross, VA. Admission is free.
