George Washington Birthplace to Host Discussion with Artist Ebby Hynson

Noted Colonial Beach Artist Ebby Hynson will be at George Washington Birthplace National Monument on Saturday, March 30. Her informal discussion will start at 2 p.m. in the park's visitor center.

Nine of Mrs. Hynson's oil paintings depicting her interpretations of Colonial life at George Washington Birthplace are currently on exhibit at the National Monument's visitor center. The pieces are on loan from the artist through July 2013.

"We are honored by Mrs. Hynson and her work on so many levels," says Park Superintendent Lucy Lawliss. "We have first been honored to be an inspiration to so much of her work over so many years. We are now honored to display her art, and we will be delighted by her upcoming appearance."

The discussion will be of particular relevance to aspiring artists of all ages as Mrs. Hynson discusses the inspirations of her career.
