



# Lands Resource Program Office Pages (National Capital Region)



## NATIONAL CAPITAL REGION

1. Over 4,000 land records have been scanned and are searchable through an internal web engine.
2. Each park Reservation was researched, mapped by coordinate geometry, and attributed.
3. A final map, Land Management Status, was created showing properties managed by NPS and transferred to the District of Columbia by purpose.
