



The Artist-in-Residence Program at Glacier National Park offers professional artists the opportunity to pursue their artistic discipline while being surrounded by the park's inspiring landscape. The selected artists will be given rent-free use of a furnished park house. Artists must be self-sufficient and provide all of their necessary supplies. This call applies to all sessions. While artists may indicate which session is their preference, selection for that session is not guaranteed. Session dates are non-negotiable.

Important Dates (no exceptions):

2/15/2013	All application materials must be postmarked
2/22/2013	All application materials must be received
4/30/2013	Artist selection notification
6/17/2013 - 7/15/2013	Residency Session I
8/19/2013 - 9/16/2013	Residency Session II

In return, participating artists are asked to:

1. Comply with all National Park Service and Glacier National Park policy.
2. Present a series of public programs during their residency. Artist will also present one program after their residency in their hometown. These programs must be related to their experience as the artist-in-residence at Glacier National Park, and support the mission and values of the National Park Service. Programs can be demonstrations, talks, exploratory walks, or performances. Artists must provide their own supplies and equipment for these presentations.
3. Sale of art while in residence at Glacier National Park is prohibited.
4. The contract may be terminated by Glacier National Park at anytime.

Agreement to the guidelines above does not guarantee selection for the Artist-in-Residence Program at Glacier National Park.
