() APGAR: 194 sites which includes two campground host sites and an additional 10 group sites; largest campground in Glacier National Park. There are two handicap accessible sites and three sites for hikers and bicyclists. Located at the foot of Lake McDonald. Groceries, café, visitor center are located in Apgar Village, one-quarter mile and full services available in West Glacier, two miles. Full host site hook-ups. Maximum trailer length is 40 feet. RV dump station, flush toilets and drinking water are available. Picnic area, boating, fishing, hiking, horseback riding, naturalist programs and amphitheater are adjacent. Hosts needed May through the end of September.
() AVALANCHE: 87 sites, located 16 miles from West Glacier along the Going-to-the-Sun Road. Campstore, café and gasoline are located at Lake McDonald lodge, five miles away. Host site has full hook-ups; however, a generator located near the site supplies electricity. Flush toilets and drinking water are available. A dump station is not located in this campground. Low voltage appliances are advised. Picnic area and popular nature trail nearby, 1.7 mile moderate uphill hike to Avalanche Lake. Ranger station located in campground. Special emphasis on food storage regulation as pertaining to bears. Host needed mid-June through Labor Day.
() BOWMAN LAKE: 48 sites, located at the foot of scenic Bowman Lake, reached by narrow dirt roads in the North Fork area of the park. Store, gas and café located in Polebridge, Montana, seven miles. Host site has a water spigot hookup. Primitive type environment: pit toilets and drinking water are available, but no dump station or electricity. Ranger station is located in campground. Boating (10hp max), excellent fishing and hiking are available. This is a unique area, which will require some extra effort, but it is well worth it. Host couple needed mid-June through mid-September.
() FISH CREEK: Reservation campground for visitors. 176 sites, located on the north shore of Lake McDonald. Groceries, café, visitor center located in Apgar Village, two miles and full services are available in West Glacier, four miles. Full hook-ups at host site. Flush toilets, drinking water and a dump station are available. Maximum trailer length is 35 feet. Ranger station is located in campground. Evening naturalist programs are presented in amphitheater. Boating, fishing, horseback riding and hiking are available. Hosts needed mid-June through Labor Day.
() SPRAGUE CREEK: 25 sites which include one handicap accessible site and two sites for hikers and bicyclists. Café, campstore and gasoline are available at Lake McDonald Lodge, one mile. No tow units permitted. Host site completed in 1999. Flush toilets and drinking water are available. Boating, fishing, hiking and horseback riding are available. Hosts are needed mid-May through September.

Glacier valley on the east side of the park. Café, store and a large hotel are located nearby. Full hook-ups are in the host site. Flush toilets, drinking water and a dump station are available. Maximum recommended trailer length is 35 feet. Ranger station is located near campground. Very popular hiking area, fishing, boating, horseback riding interpretive programs and wildlife viewing are available. Hosts needed June through September.
() RISING SUN: 83 sites, located near St. Mary Lake on the east side of the park. Full services are located in St. Mary, Montana, six miles. Campstore, café and cabins are available at the campground. Full host site hook-ups. Flush toilets, drinking water and a dump station are available. Ranger station is located in campground. Boating, fishing and hiking are available. Hosts are needed June through Labor Day.
() ST. MARY: Reservation campground for visitors. 148 sites, located at the foot of St. Mary Lake on the east side of the park. Café, store, gasoline and other services are available in St. Mary, Montana, one mile. Full host site hook-ups. Maximum recommended trailer length is 30 feet. Flush toilets, drinking water and a dump station are available in the campground. Visitor center and ranger station complex is nearby Boating, fishing and hiking are available. The Blackfeet Reservation is adjacent to the park. Host needed June through Labor Day.

() TWO MEDICINE: 99 sites, located at the foot of Two Medicine Lake. A concession campstore/self-serve snack bar is located nearby. Full services are available in East Glacier, 12 miles. Full host site hook-ups. Flush toilets, drinking water and a dump station are available. Maximum recommended trailer length is 32 feet. Ranger station is located in campground. Boating, fishing, hiking and viewing wildlife is available. Hosts needed June through Labor Day.
