- Annual/Lifetime passes accepted

Bus drops off at the Apgar Visitor Center or Avalanche Creek next to the free Glacier Park shuttles. Last bus to Kalispell leaves the park after the last shuttle returns from Logan Pass. Spend a half day or full day in the park. Hike, picnic, sightsee, explore!
