First Name and Last Name – Your name

Address, City, State, Zip, Country – Your mailing address

Phone – Best phone number to contact you

Group Members Names – First and Last name of all other members in group

Emergency Contact Information

Name, Phone – Name and phone number of your emergency contact (required)

Relation – your relation to your emergency contact. If other add note on second page

Trip Information

Entry and Exit Date – First and last day of your trip

Entry and Exit Location – Where you will be starting and ending your trip

Entry and Exit Vehicle – Method of travel to your entry or exit location (kayak, private vessel drop off, Hike etc)

Group Size – Number of people in your group

Number of Kayaks – Number of kayaks your group will be traveling with

Rental Company – Who owns your Kayak (personal, friend, GBSK, etc)

Kayak, Life Vest, Tent Colors – Brief description of each

Number of requested Bear Canisters – How many bear cannisters you would like to check out. Each bear can hold approximately 6 person days of food

Safety Gear – Check all items that you are carrying with you on your trip.

Itinerary – Describe in as much detail as possible your intended route, for each row list the date and general area where you plan to camp (trip location) for that night.
